



Internship description Garden education

Work area

- Approximately 4000 m² of total garden space
- Junior City Farmer garden - Children's garden: teaching sensory experiences, cultivation, care and harvesting of vegetable crops, getting to know the garden and its inhabitants in a playful way
- Garden of diversity: comprehensive knowledge of vegetable diversity, garden design and biodiversity
- Workshop rooms: cooking and playful knowledge transfer

Conditions

- Internship duration: at least **1 month**
- Mon - Fri mostly mornings from **8 am to 1 pm** (time varies depending on the workshop)
- Number of hours: **20 - 25 hours per week** (1 day off for 20 hours per week)

Tasks

- Supporting garden workshops for children and adults
- Helping to design the educational programs
- Possible activities: garden educational methods and games, looking after the children's beds, harvesting and cooking fruit and vegetable varieties, designing garden educational objects, assistance at events, ...

Requirements

- Educational knowledge is beneficial but not required!
- Interest and enthusiasm for working with people of all ages
- Openness and teamwork skills - Respectful interaction with children and colleagues as the basis for good cooperation
- Independence, initiative, reliability and punctuality
