



Internship description Horticulture

Garden areas and their thematic focus

Approximately 4000 m² total garden area under organic cultivation

- Garden of diversity: wide range of species and varieties, teaching cultivation techniques and processing methods, compatibility of landscape design and vegetable growing
- Junior City Farmer Garden - Educational garden: getting to know vegetable crops and their cultivation, getting to know the garden and its inhabitants in a playful way, sensory training

Conditions

- Internship duration: at least **1 month**
- Period: **March – November** (July and August: only one internship spot available)
- Monday - Friday from **9:00 am to 2:00 pm**
- Weekly hours: **20 - 25 hours** (1 day off for 20 hours per week)

Tasks

- various plant cultivation and manual activities
- sowing, planting, harvesting, bed preparation, horticultural care measures, maintenance of garden educational objects, assistance at events, ...
- Despite our efforts to provide as diverse an insight as possible into everyday gardening, there may be a seasonal accumulation of certain tasks

Requirements

- Gardening knowledge is beneficial but not required!
- Interest and enthusiasm for gardening as well as physical resilience
- Openness and teamwork skills - Respectful interaction with colleagues as the basis for a good working atmosphere
- Independence, initiative, reliability and punctuality
