



## Internship description Slow Flowering

### Garden Areas and Their Thematic Focus

Approx. 4000 m<sup>2</sup> total garden area under organic cultivation

- Two flower strips totaling about 40 m in length and 1 m in width
- Organic cultivation practices
- Organized according to the market gardening system

### Conditions

- Only one internship position available!
- Internship duration: at least **1 month**
- Period: March to November
- Monday to Friday, **9:00 am to 2:00 pm**
- Weekly hours: **15 - 20 hours** (across 3 - 4 weekdays)

### Tasks

- Various horticultural tasks, as well as light manual work, depending on the timing of the internship
- Sowing, planting, bed preparation, routine garden maintenance, etc.
- Harvesting and tending flowers
- Preparing bunches for direct farm sales at our market stand
- Possibly delivering flowers to restaurants, institutions, etc.

### Requirements

- Gardening knowledge is beneficial but not required!
- Interest and enthusiasm for flower cultivation, as well as physical resilience
- Openness and teamwork skills —respectful interaction with colleagues as the basis for a good working atmosphere
- Independence, initiative, reliability and punctuality
- If a final certificate is required: daily keyword-based log of tasks performed, for documentation purposes

### What we offer

- The opportunity to contribute to an emerging cut flower operation, part of a garden-based educational project
- Insights into domestic cut flower cultivation within a market gardening structure
- Knowledge transfer on flower cultivation, biodiversity and basic floristry
- Working outdoors in a green environment with minimal stress
- Free participation in our workshop program for adults

5. Finish with a certificate
